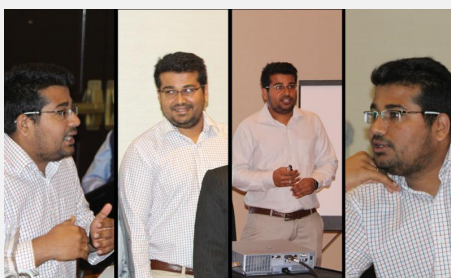

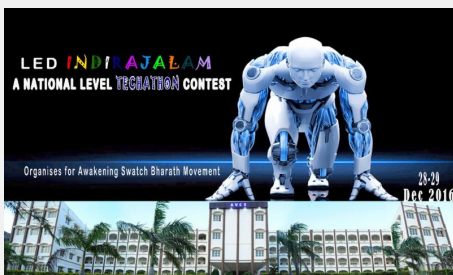


SIGHT Islamabad Launches "Let's Breathe Clean Together"
