Participants from seven different countries and three Regions joined in a round-table conversation about SIGHT and sustainable development projects. People asked great questions, like “How do we get community residents to trust us and realize that we have good intentions, while ensuring that the trust doesn’t turn into dependency?” and requested more materials to strengthen effective proposal writing skills. As a response, the SIGHT Education Subcommittee will be offering two upcoming webinars on how to design strong project proposals. This month I also attended the SIGHT Steering Committee in-person meeting, and I am so excited to share the major initiatives that were approved for 2019:
