Dear IEEE SIGHT volunteers,

This month started on a high note for me with a presentation at the IEEE-HKN Student Leadership Conference held at Tufts University in Boston. Sharing about SIGHT project funding with the Chapter presidents in attendance generated a lot of interest as all HKN members have community service requirements as part of the program. I see this as a natural partnership opportunity, and expect to see project proposals from these new partners in 2020!

One of the accomplishments I am most excited about this year is the new jointly-funded model we designed as a way to partner with IEEE Societies on sustainable development projects. The SIGHT Projects Committee held a closed Call for Proposals in October for Society SIGHT Groups, and decided to provide funding for four projects together with each Society:

- 1. LoRaWAN Enabled Remote Solar Photovoltaic Energy Monitoring System with the **Microwave Theory and Techniques Society**
- 2. Automated and Sustainable Drip Irrigation System in Rural Nicaragua with the **Electron Devices Society**

- 3. Deployment of a Wireless Communication System for Catastrophic Emergencies with the **Antennas and Propagation Society**
- 4. High Impedance Fault (HIF) Detection Project For Saving Lives with the **Industry Applications Society**

I was thrilled to see a high level of commitment and engagement from these Society partners, and look forward to building on this strong foundation to partner with more Societies in 2020.

Another significant accomplishment for SIGHT this year is the creation of a fund with the IEEE Foundation. This fund will allow SIGHT to grow its reach and better meet the needs of IEEE members by providing an additional source of income (donations) to fund projects.
