Video: Effective Low-Cost Prototyping (A Recorded SIGHT Webinar)

A Silicon Valley saying is "Never go to a meeting without a prototype." While an idea expressed orally can be descriptive and convincing, almost any idea's value can be magnified greatly if coupled with an effective prototype. Effective prototypes help investors, business partners, suppliers, and employees all understand and, ideally, buy into an idea. Prototypes can take many forms, from simple sketches to full pre-production working models of complex products. Prototypes can vary in cost, from paper storyboards and wire frames for computer programs and physical models made from popsicle sticks and playdough, to finely machined, hand-crafted precision products. The webinar focuses on low cost prototypes that can convey the entrepreneurial idea to stakeholders.
