Dear IEEE SIGHT volunteers,

I'm excited to give an update on the SIGHT Steering Committee's progress in March. The Committee had its first teleconference call, during which every member actively participated in formulating the strategic plan to achieve the 2019 program goals. We were all encouraged by the ten new applications for SIGHT groups, nineteen projects proposals from thirteen different SIGHT groups received for the year's first Call for

Proposals, and the 721 new individual members in February - a record high number since the beginning of individual membership. The Steering Committee is happy to be a part of an engaged and motivated network, and reminds you to pass along the word about SIGHT to your fellow IEEE volunteers.

Please join with me in welcoming a special addition to the 2019 SIGHT Steering Committee, Dr. Ajay Poddar. Dr. Poddar will serve as the Chair for the **Ad-hoc Strategic Partnerships Committee**, organized to strengthen relationships with local Sections, key volunteer leaders, and IEEE's technical societies to ensure prevailing partnership for long-term impact. This Committee will focus on collaborating, engaging and initiating partnership with internal IEEE programs, external humanitarian technology organizations, and industries to sustain and safeguard SIGHT's vision. I look forward to seeing all that Dr. Poddar and his committee will accomplish this year.

A new initiative that I am very excited to introduce to you is the first **"Ask the Chair" Session**. This program has been designed as a forum for IEEE SIGHT members, followers, and fans with an intentional, interactive space to ask the SIGHT Chair for advice relating to sustainable development projects. Remember to keep the IEEE HAC & SIGHT 2019 application deadlines in mind if you are looking for funding sources for your sustainable development activities.

- **IEEE HAC Projects:** 01 April, 15 July, 09 September (only if funds remain)
- **IEEE HAC Events:** 20 May, 19 August
- **IEEE SIGHT Projects:** 22 April, 15 August
- **IEEE HAC Conference Participation Program:** 24 Apr, 29 May, 26 June, 31 July, 28 Aug, 25 Sept, 30 Oct

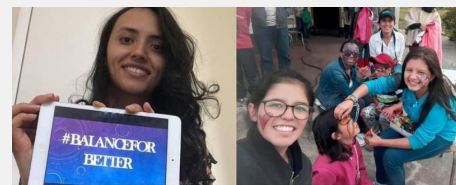

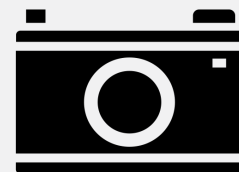
#BalanceForBetter
