## Video: Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) A recorded IEEE SIGHT webinar

M&E is often overlooked as a secondary need both in business and development, with many thinking that traditional tools are too costly or time-consuming to monitor performance. Consequently, many organizations fall short of capturing the real impact on the beneficiaries of a particular project. The Lean Data approach is a response to this shortcoming that applies opportunities for experimentation with lean sources of data obtained through low cost technologies (LCTs) including SMS, e-mail surveys, phone calls, sensors, and voice responses in order to explicitly assess the impact perceived by the intended beneficiaries beyond the scope of financial flows or standard rates of return. Join Dr. Ku McMahan and Saad Usmani as we discuss the need for ongoing monitoring, the Lean Data approach, and SWFF M&E case studies.
