Note from the Chair



Dear IEEE SIGHT volunteers,

Hope you are safe and healthy. I'm very excited to share the results of the first-ever joint IEEE Humanitarian Activities Committee (HAC) and SIGHT Special Call for Proposals related to COVID-19. We received 112 qualified proposals from 29 Countries in 5 IEEE Regions and approved support for 73 proposals from 25 countries. I'm truly delighted to see this outcome and the tremendous response from SIGHT volunteers across the globe towards the joint COVID proposal call. In 2019, SIGHT doubled the number of proposals received and supported since its inception; now we have established a new growth benchmark with this joint effort accelerating SIGHT projects growth by at least 5X times to date.

To sustain this momentum, we have established five Communities of Practice (CoPs) on the following thematic areas: Medical Devices, ICT, Food Security, Infection Control Devices, and PPE/Community Sensitization. The goal of these CoPs is to bring in projects by thematic area to increase impact, member engagement and professional development. Each CoP will facilitate active information sharing among projects in that thematic area, provide guidance when needed, establish

key metrics, and share collective learnings for effective replication and scaling.

Other exciting news is SIGHT will be launching the “SIGHT global summit” program digitally in Q3 2020. The goal of this program is to provide a global platform virtually for SIGHT volunteers to showcase their impactful work, share their experience, and seek direct guidance from SIGHT executive leadership. We will share more details on the next joint call for proposals and SIGHT global summit program in our next newsletter.

Recently, I had the opportunity to promote SIGHT among hundreds of students in unique programs such as IEEE YESIST12 and **Lehigh University's Mountaintop Initiative**. We also organized the first SIGHT town-hall in Australia where I had the pleasure to meet with grassroots leaders and discussed regional strategies to accelerate SIGHT growth in local sections and universities.

I'm thrilled to welcome the members of the newly formed “IEEE Columbus Section SIGHT” to the global SIGHT community. I'm excited to see the launch of the SIGHT funded project “Smart Classroom Among the Woods” in Kerala, India. Also, I highly encourage you to participate in the **IEEE HAC Events** revised call for proposal which is open until 1 September 2020. Volunteers are the pillars of the SIGHT program; we would love to highlight your stories in our newsletter. Please continue to share your updates with us at sight@ieee.org

Thank you all again for continuing to invest your time and efforts in IEEE SIGHT-related activities. What you are doing makes a long-term impact!



Results of HAC/SIGHT COVID Projects Call for Proposals




Projects that have been funded by the HAC/SIGHT COVID call for proposals will be able to use the above insignia.

IEEE Region Affiliation of HAC/SIGHT COVID Projects Funded




Locations of HAC/SIGHT COVID Funded Projects

News from SIGHT Groups

Columbus Section SIGHT - Milo Grogan Fresh Produce Farm Project

This project is one of the awardees of the HAC/SIGHT COVID Call for

Proposals. The new IEEE Columbus Section SIGHT is cleaning out an existing blighted building for demolition. The location is perfect to serve the vendors, as well as the population that they are targeting, in a designated food desert with the highest rate of infection from the coronavirus in their county in central Ohio. There are very few stores in this area, and residents, including the elderly, in the Milo Grogan area have to travel great distances on public transportation to get fresh produce. Once demolished, the group will pour a footer to place the shipping containers on and insert prefab racks and shelving. They will build the greenhouse on the top of the infrastructure. The group has many volunteers and looks to organizations and businesses for in-kind donations as needed. The primary collaboration consists of IEEE, Cultivate, and Family Services Council. They are having discussions with local vendors, restaurants, stores to maintain a consistent income stream.
